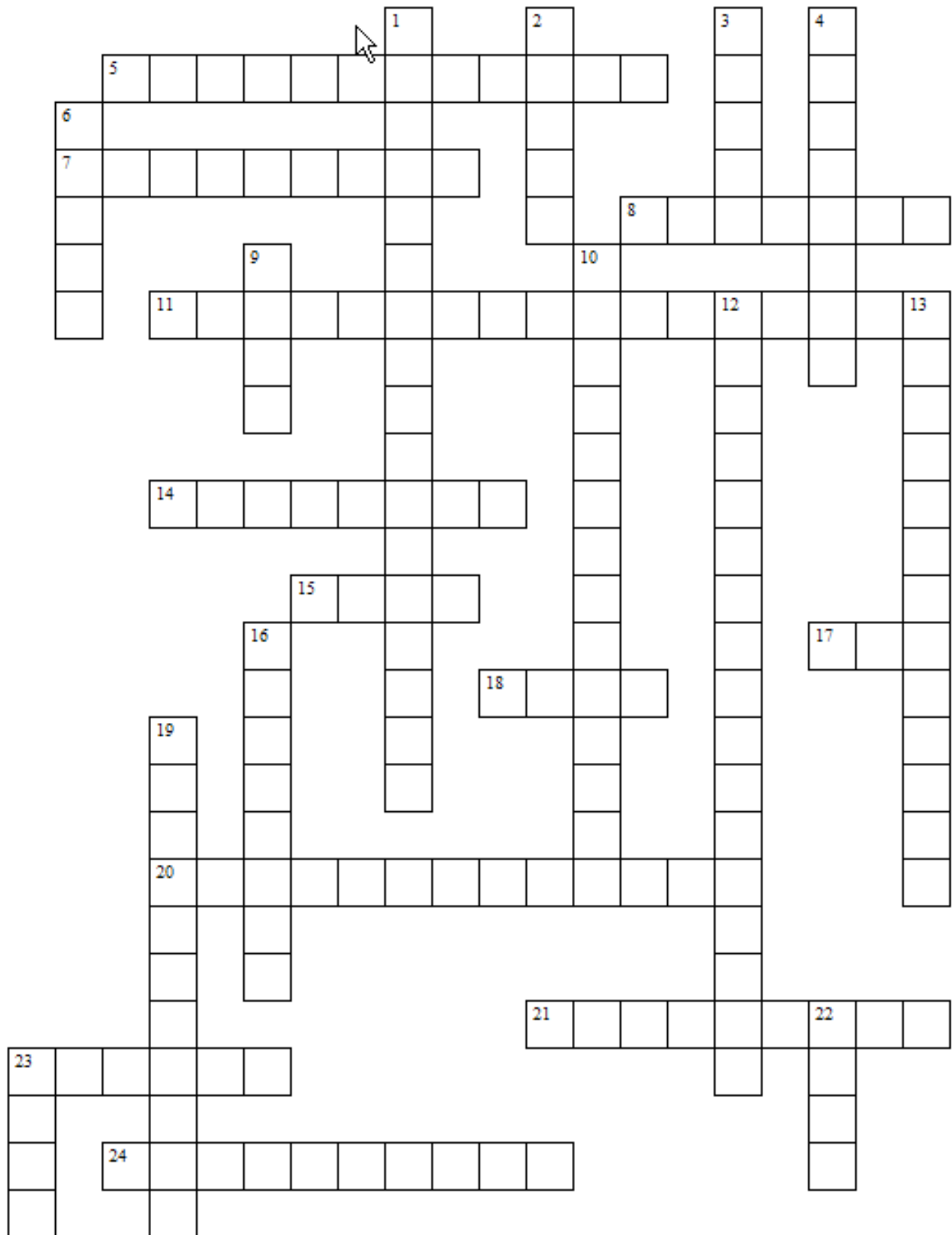


Cardiac Crossword



ACROSS

- 5 Chamber that receives blood from the coronary sinus (2 words with space)
- 7 Valve between the right atrium and right ventricle
- 8 Term used to describe a part of the heart during contraction
- 11 First branches of the ascending aorta (2 words with space)
- 14 Circulation between the left ventricle and the right atrium
- 15 Superior aspect of the heart
- 17 Amount of blood in the ventricles at the end of diastole (abbreviation)
- 18 Number of blood vessels that normally enter the left atrium
- 20 Means no change in volume during ventricular contraction
- 21 Circulation between the right ventricle and the left atrium
- 23 Name of the valve between the left atrium and the left ventricle
- 24 CO divided by SV (2 words with space)

DOWN

- 1 Structures that keep the AV valves from being pushed backwards during systole (2 words with space)
- 2 Heart sound associated with the closure of the AV valves
- 3 Defined as carrying blood back towards the heart
- 4 Pressure represented by (120) in a BP of 120 over 80
- 6 Chambers of the heart with the longest period of relaxation
- 9 Part of the aorta between the ascending and descending parts
- 10 The amount of blood pumped by the heart per minute (2 words with space)
- 12 SV divided by the EDV
- 13 Amount of blood pumped by the heart in one heart beat (2 words with space)
- 16 Term used to describe a part of the heart during rest
- 19 Section of the vascular system between arteries and veins (pleural)
- 22 Inferior aspect of the heart
- 23 Unit of pressure used for blood pressure
